Working Safely

IOSH Working Safely is a one-day health and safety awareness course aimed primarily at those who do not have supervisory or managerial positions; although the latter often find this a useful introductory programme. This new version is proving to be highly popular, owing to its highly interactive structure.

Prerequisites: There are no formal entry requirements for delegates undertaking this qualification.

Course Content: There are 5 modules making up the course.

- ✚ Introducing working safely - An introduction to the course and the principles of why working safely is important.
- ✚ Defining hazard and risk - understanding what constitutes a hazard and recognising the different types and understanding the principles of risk and risk assessment.
- ✚ Identifying common hazards - Recognising 18 of the most common workplace hazards, how they arise and how to remove or reduce the risk.
- ✚ Improving safety performance - understanding the safe systems of work, how to use PPE, recognising safety signs, an overview of emergency procedures, first aid and basics of measuring health and safety and reporting incidents.
- ✚ Protecting our environment - understanding how industry affects the environment and discovering what industry and the individual can do to reduce pollution and waste

Duration of Course: Delegates who successfully complete the written and practical assessments can choose to receive either an IOSH Working Safely certificate or an IOSH Passport.
