The NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Safety & Health is a leading foundation course intended to enable managers, supervisor's employee representatives; and those making day-to-day health and safety decisions at work to implement modern risk management practices and attain a nationally recognised health and safety qualification.

Professional Body Membership:

Holders of the National General Certificate are eligible for membership of the following professional bodies, subject to meeting the necessary post-qualification experience requirements

- ❑ Institution of Occupational Safety & Health (IOSH)
- ❑ International Institute of Risk & Safety Management (IIRSM)

Prior knowledge: There are no entry requirements although it should be noted that the examination requires the delegate to write a short report so a good standard of written English is necessary.

Examination & Assessment: Delegates will be expected to complete two exam papers, both of which are sat on the same day and a practical health & safety assessment of a workplace.

Duration of Course: 10 Days intensive tuition (2x1 week)
