Paediatric (Babies & Children) First Aid

This course focuses on emergency scenarios that are faced by professionals, including teachers, au pairs and playgroup leaders, looking after young children. It meets Ofsted requirements for childcare professionals and is recognised by the National Childminding Association (NCMA) & Pre School Learning Alliance (PLA) and the requirements for nannies under the DfES Approved Carers Scheme. It can also be used as evidence for employees working towards an NVQ in Childcare and Education.

Who should attend? This course is for people working with younger children - those up to eight years old – or working towards an NVQ in Childcare and Education.

Course content

- First Aid kit and action planning
- Treatment of an unconscious baby or child
- Resuscitation
- Choking
- Wounds, injuries and bleeding
- Burns and scalds
- Baby and child emergencies:
 - Head injuries
 - Seizures
 - Diabetic emergencies
 - Asthma and allergies (including bites & stings)
 - Meningitis
 - Croup
 - Fevers
 - Medical emergencies
