

Roof Top Safety Awareness



This course will promote a good understanding of rooftop safety issues and enable delegates to recognise the main rooftop hazards & precautions that may need to be taken. The course includes an overview of the Working at Heights Regulations and how the regulations can be implemented whilst working on rooftops and access and egress from the work area.

Who should attend? Individuals required to work at height on exposed flat roof areas, especially telecommunications engineers and building maintenance workers.

Prior knowledge An awareness of Health & Safety issues would be an advantage but not essential.

Course content

- Working At Height Regulations
- Activities and accident causation
- Common hazards associated with rooftop activities.
- Risk Assessment and control measures
- Access and egress using ladders (fixed and portable)
- Planning & preparation
- Test
